### People 1800 – 1840's

Patrick Brown – Merchant, American George Lodge Master 1797 – lived on Broad Street (Old Main Street) Georgia Pacific area, known as “a Bullish Scotsman”

Hardy Murfree – American George Lodge Treasurer 1797

Ed Murphy – Shoemaker

Moses Clements – Indian Queen Innkeeper

William Rea – American George Lodge Secretary 1797, shop owner, ship owner

Dr. Isaac Pipkin – committed suicide in New Orleans, LA 1850

Dr. Thomas O'Dwyer – Irishman, bachelor doctor

Dr. Isaac Foster – partner of Dr. O'Dwyer, alcoholic, dissolved partnership in 1813

Ellis Gray Blake – associate at Rea Store

Joseph Dickinson – General, bought Melrose 1810, own an Inn at Winton, his widow married Dr. Bryan Bunbury, uncle to Dr. O'Dwyer

Benjamin Camp – partner of Joseph G. Rea, later founding family of Union Camp Lumber
