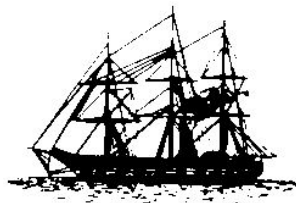

Mission Statement

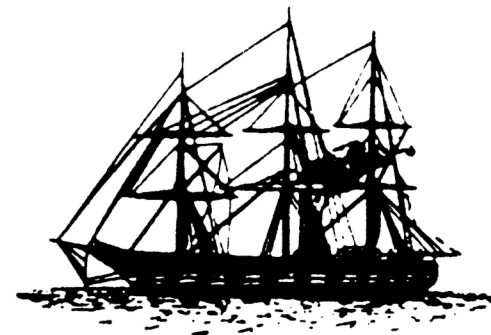
